



Steps for making Hajj in order with rulings for each action.

1	Day 8 The Day of Tarwiah Ihram is intending to make Hajj and entering into the state for making the rituals	1	Sunnah	Bathing, and cleaning. Using perfume (for men before entering into rituals).	Nothing
		2	Sunnah	Men wear a white clean two-piece garment consisting of izar [for the lower part of the body] and ridaa' [for the upper part of the body]. Women can wear any suitable garment so long as it is not decorative or showy.	Nothing
		3	Sunnah	To make invocation for intending to make Hajj before leaving the place he is staying in, and says "Labbayk Hajjan" or "Labbayk Allahumma Hajjan"	Nothing

2	Day 9 Day of Arafa Night of Muzdalifah	7	Sunnah	To head to Arafa after sunrise while reciting "Talbiah"	Nothing
		8	Sunnah	Listening to Khutba and praying Dhuhur and Asr at the same time (shortened to 2 rak'a each) with one Azan and two Iqamas	Nothing
		9	Sunnah	To be in a state of purity in making Dua'a while facing Qibla and rising hands	Nothing
		10	Compulsory	Standing/staying in Arafa until sunset	See (3)
		11	Permissible	To stand/stay anywhere in Arafa except a place called "Batin Uranah"	Nothing
		12	Sunnah	To head to Muzdalifah after sunset while calm and peaceful without haste	Nothing
		13	Dislike	To fast Day of Arafa if you are a pilgrim, permissible if you don't find Udhiya	Nothing
		14	Sunnah	Perform Maghrib and Isha prayers (3&2 rak'a respectively) in Muzdalifah with one Azan and two Iqamas	Nothing
		15	Compulsory	To sleep/stay at Muzdalifah until midnight	Expiation
		16	Sunnah	To sleep at Muzdalifah until sunrise and to set after Fajr prayer for Dua'a until mid morning.	Nothing
		17	Permissible	To leave Muzdalifah after midnight (elderly & women and their supporters)	Nothing
3	Day 10 Day of Sacrifice Day of Eid	18	Sunnah	To head to Mina before sunrise while reciting Talbiah and making Dua'a	Nothing

		21	Sunnah	To throw the 7 stones continuously while making Takbeer with each one. Stand making Ka'ba to your left and Mina to your right (Don't recite Talbiah)	Nothing
		22	Compulsory	Udhiya for Hajj with Tamatu, can be done from Eid day until the sunset of the 3 rd day of Tashreeq, anywhere in Makkah or Mina	See (4)
		23	Compulsory	Shaving or cutting hair for men. Women have to cut only a fingertip's length of hair from each braid	Expiation
		24	Compulsory	Perform Tawaf Al-Ifadah without haste and while covering the shoulders. May be performed later before leaving Makkah and would replace Tawaf Al-wada'a	Hajj not complete
		25	Sunnah	To use perfume before when going to Haram for Tawaf Al-Ifadah after shaving and throwing the stones	Nothing
		26	Compulsory	Perform As-Sa'i for Hajj	Hajj not complete
		27	Permissible	For men, if performed 2 of the following 3 (throwing the stones, Shaving & Tawaf), all Hajj prohibited actions are permissible except the wife, this is called "The 1 st relief". If performed all 3, then all Hajj prohibited actions are now permissible including the wife, this is called "The complete relief"	Nothing
		28	Compulsory	Sleep/stay at Mina (at least more the midnight)	Expiation
		29	Sunnah	To make Takbeer after throwing Jamaratul Aqabah on Eid day and finish after Asr prayer on Day 13	Nothing
		30	Permissible	To perform the following rituals with no particular order (Throwing stones, Udhiya, Shaving & Tawaf)	Nothing
		31	Sunnah	Shortening 4-rak'a prayers but without combination	Nothing
4	Day 11 Day 12 Day 13 Days of Tashreeq	32	Sunnah	Making Takbeer after the five prayers	See (5)
		33	Compulsory	Throw stones at the Small Jamarah, then the middle Jamarah and finally the large Jamarah (Jamaratul Aqabah) in this particular order	Expiation
		34	Sunnah	To throw the 7 stones continuously while making Takbeer with each one. Throwing time starts after midday until Fajr the next day	Nothing
		35	Sunnah	Making long Dua'a after throwing the small Jamarah while standing to its right, facing Qibla and rising the hands	Nothing
		36	Sunnah	Making long Dua'a after throwing the middle Jamarah while standing to its left, facing Qibla and rising the hands	Nothing
		37	Sunnah	Throw Jamaratul Aqabah while making Ka'ba to your left and Mina to your right (Don't make Dua'a afterwards)	Nothing
		38	Compulsory	Sleep/stay at Mina (at least more than midnight)	Expiation
		39	Sunnah	Stay until the 13 th day, it is permissible to leave in the 12 th day (haste leave)	Nothing
		40	Compulsory	If you want to "haste leave", you must throw all three Jamarat and leave Mina before sunset of the 12 th day	See (6)
		41	Compulsory	Perform Tawaf Al-wada'a, except for women in their monthly period or women in labor	Expiation

* The Muslim has a choice to perform Hajj alone, with Qiran or with Tamatu'

* The difference between Qiran and Hajj alone is 2 rituals:
1- When making Ihram, the pilgrim says: "Labbayk Hajjan" for Hajj alone, or says: "Labbayk Umratan Wa Hajjan" for Qiran (combining Umrah with hajj at the same time)

* It is forbidden to commit any Hajj prohibited actions:

1	Removal of hair from the head or anywhere else
2	Clipping fingernails
3	Putting on perfume
4	All preludes to sexual intercourse
5	Hunting animals
6	Contracting marriage
7	Sexual intercourse
8	Wearing stitched garments (Prohibited for men).
9	Covering the head (Prohibited for men).
10	Wearing Niqaab (Prohibited for women).
11	Wearing gloves (Prohibited for women).

(1) If a pilgrim makes a condition in his intention as a precaution in case he is prevented from completing a rite and is not able to complete that rite, then there is nothing on him, but if he does not make such a condition, and he is unable to complete the rite, then he must offer an expiation (slaughtering a sacrificial animal, or if unable, fasting for 10 days).

(2) Reciting Talbiah: Labbayk Allahumma labbayk, labbayka laa shareeka laka labbayk, innal hamda Wan-ni'mata, laka wal mulk, laa shareeka lak

(3) If Standing in Arafa is not performed, then Hajj is void. If pilgrim left Arafa before sunset, then there is expiation

(4) If pilgrim did not find Udhiya (Qurbani) then they should fast Tashreeq days (3 days) and 7 days after returning home

(5) Making Takbeer: Allho Akbar, Allho Akbar, La ilaha illa Allah, Allaho Akbar, Allaho Akbar, Wa lillah al-hamd

(6) If sunset while in Mina, the pilgrim must stay till next day

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With this, you have completed your Hajj in the way that was prescribed by the Prophet PBUH.

Corners of Hajj: 1- Ihram 2- Standing in Arafa 3- Tawaf Al-Ifadah 4- As-Sa'i

Obligations of Hajj: 1-Ihram from your proper Miqat 2-Standing in Arafa till sunset 3-Sleep/stay in Muzdalifah till midnight 4- Sleep/stay in Mina in the days of Tashreeq (11-12-13) 5- Throw the Jamarat in order 6- Shaving 7- Tawaf Al-wada'a
